In 2006, her cover of "Lion Song" was featured on *Songs for Sixty-Five Roses*, an album of North Carolina musicians benefiting the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation. She was nominated by the 2006 *LA Weekly* Theatre Awards for Best Original Music for the songs she wrote for "See Rock City," a play by Arlene Hutton which premiered in Los Angeles.
