note that it is for people who have current badges in Early Response. If you took the ERT classes around the time of Katrina, you are currently out of date and will need to take an update class. A new element has been added to current badging: background checks are required for all people seeking badging.

ERT classes (both first time and update) will be offered at MERCI May 14-15; August 13-14; and November 19-20. You can take UMVIM leadership training at MERCI also on May 14-15. To register, and for more information, go to www.merciumc.org. Early Response Training is critical to our being effective responders and I highly recommend taking the class. The need in TN is huge and I know that our District has hundreds of people who want to respond.
